Performance

Students will be remaining at the theatre from the time they are dropped off until after the performance, so if you could pack food, some snacks and a water bottle that would be fantastic (please do not pack anything with nuts due to dietary requirements for students, and no sugary drinks in case of spillages around costumes)! Students can be picked up after the concert from the stage area, which we will remind everyone of in the lead up to the concert and on the performance day.

Please label EVERYTHING of your child's belongings.

DROP OFF: Everyone will be informed where the drop off location will be closer to the date of the concert. We are just clarifying with the venue what location will be a seamless drop off.

PICK UP: From the stage area - each class will be asked to come onto stage to be collected by the parent or guardian and then exit the building due to cleaning protocols for the next event

A reminder that ONLY staff and senior assistant teachers will be allowed backstage due to child protection and safety reasons. There will be an adult and senior student assisting with each of the groups and we will have your contact details readily available in case of emergency. NO PARENTS will be allowed past the sign in desk, so we ask for your patience and to please respect this as our staff will be working hard on the day to ensure the safety and health of your family. We understand that this might be a first concert for some of you, and we want to assure you that each student is well looked after and monitored throughout the duration of their time backstage,

You will be receiving 3 labels with your child's details printed on them during the week before the concert. Please place one on your child and one on their bag prior to drop off. The last label is for yourself so that we can link you with your child upon pickup.

As there will be no photography or videoing of the performance allowed on the day due to copyright, safety and privacy reasons, photos are being organised in both groups and individual packages during their usual class time in WEEK 8 of Term 4 – more information will be given in the lead up to concert. Students will be required to wear minimal makeup and have their hair done as per the concert, and any other concert requirements brought with them for the week of 20th November – 25th November (WEEK 8).

The performance recording has already been purchased as part of your concert package, and this will be available to everyone before the end of Term 4 2023 (we are doing our best to send it out earlier).

Tickets

Tickets are ready for purchase now. The tickets need to be printed or brought up on your mobile device and brought with you to the concert so that they can be scanned on entry. Tickets are \$25 for an adult and \$10 for children until 17 years old.

Venue Information

Doors open 30 minutes before each concert.

There will be drinks, food and snacks available for purchase before and after the concerts and during the break between junior and senior concert.

No prams are allowed in the Auditorium (there is a place to put them right outside the Auditorium door). Baby's (0–2 years old) can sit on the parents lap or you can buy an extra seat if you would like. Wheelchair places are available. Hair and Make-up

Hair:

You will need:

Hairnet, hair ties and bobby pins (the same/similar colour to hair), gel/hairspray

Preschool Concert: Everyones hair will be in a bun on the crown of the head

Junior and Senior Concert: Everyones hair will in a low bun with a middle part

Make up

You will need:

Foundation (Preschool students don't need this)

Brown/black eyeliner - both bottom and top of eye need to be lined with a slight space at the join (if unsure, then leave this component for the backstage helpers)

Brown/black mascara (depending on the student's colouring)

Natural colours for eye shadow (browns, creams, and white)

- White or cream on the whole eyelid
- Browns in the crease of the eyelid

Blush (not a circular shape, but a brush stroke upwards along the cheekbone to accentuate the facial features)

Lipstick (Any colourstay in red tones - apply at home and **do not pack in the childs bag!**)

Please pack some wipes in child's bag

There will also be a Hair and Make-up workshop at both our studios for any parents that aren't confident in doing hair and make-up. PLEASE NOTE:

This year we are transitioning to tan matte stockings. If you have shimmers and do not wish to buy another pair that is fine. 2023 will be our transition year and 2024 will be compulsory for matte stockings.

Please discuss with your class teacher whether clear bra straps or flesh bodysuits are needed to compliment the costume.

All Adult Classes will be discussed during class time regarding costuming.

BOYS: no stockings are needed, black ballet shoes, tap shoes and jazz shoes will be worn. Your teacher will let you know if any other items are needed.

Where to get your needed items?

Ballet and Jazz / Tap stockings, hair items are available to purchase from Prestige Dance Centre (while supplies last). If you need tap, jazz or ballet shoes: ballet shoes (most sizes) are in stock, the last order before the concert for jazz and tap shoes will be done on Monday 24 October. (there are other dance stores / warehouses where you might be able to find the items).
